Subject: Amendment to Medical Malpractice Program MOU

At the meeting on December 18, 2006, the Medical Malpractice Committee approved amendments to the Medical Malpractice Program Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). These amendments were primarily a result of the EIA restructure to incorporate the public entity membership, but also to clean up the document and create uniformity with other EIA documents. The amendments to the MOU were circulated to all members of the Program and their county counsels for review and comment prior to the Committee's action, with only minor grammatical changes being recommended. For your reference, the MOU amendments in redline and strikeout text are posted on the EIA's website at www.csac-eia.org.

Enclosed is a clean version of the amended MOU along with two signature pages, for execution by the members. From the EIA's standpoint, the designated representative to the EIA has authority to sign the amended MOU on behalf of the member. However, you may have internal procedures which require approval by your governing board even though the amendments approved by the Committee are non-controversial in nature.

Members must execute the amended MOU by June 30, 2007. Failure to execute the amended MOU by June 30th will be tantamount to giving notice of withdrawal from the Program effective October 1, 2007.

Upon execution of the amended MOU, please return one of the signed original signature pages to our office. Please let us know if you have any questions or need additional assistance.

17. **Complete Agreement.** Except as otherwise provided herein, this Memorandum constitutes the full and complete agreement of the members.


18. **Severability.** Should any provision of this Memorandum be judicially determined to be void or unenforceable, such determination shall not affect any remaining provision.

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
