  - Public Education Advocate

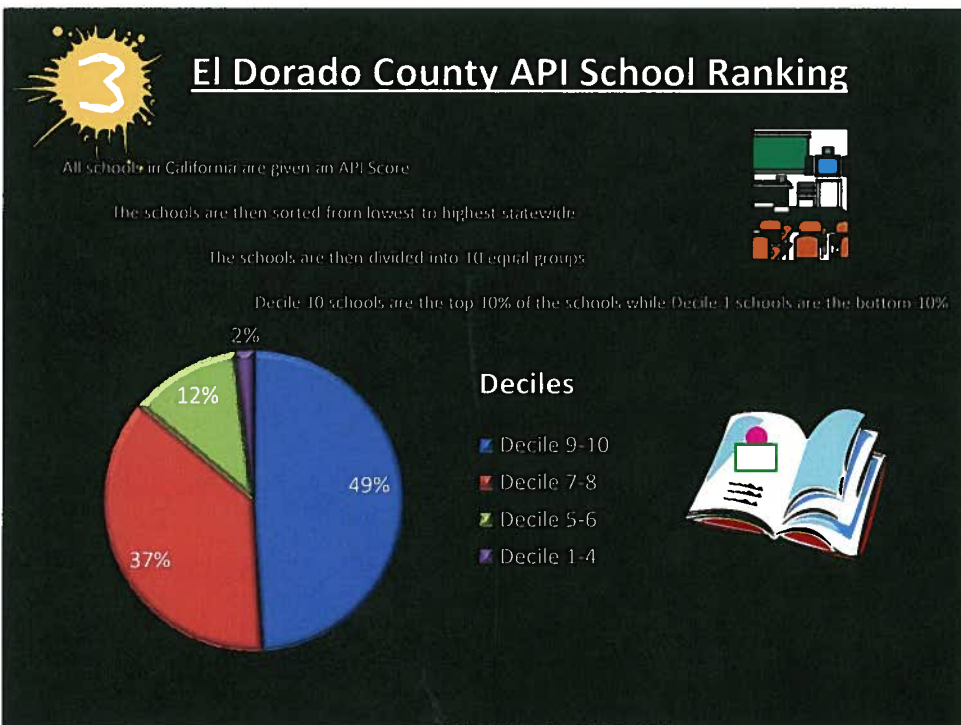

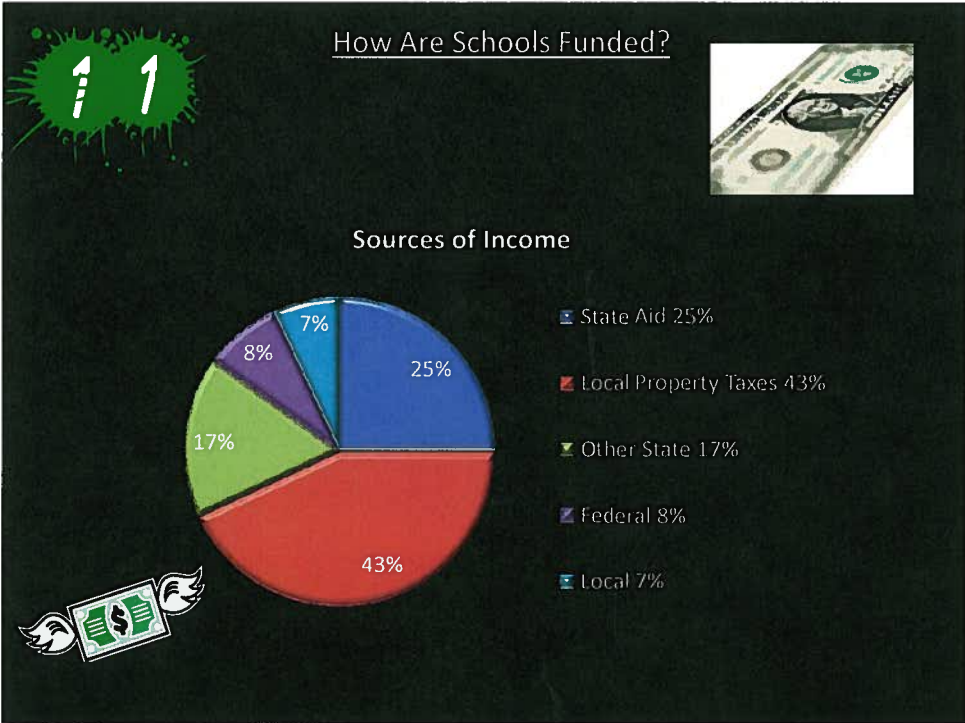
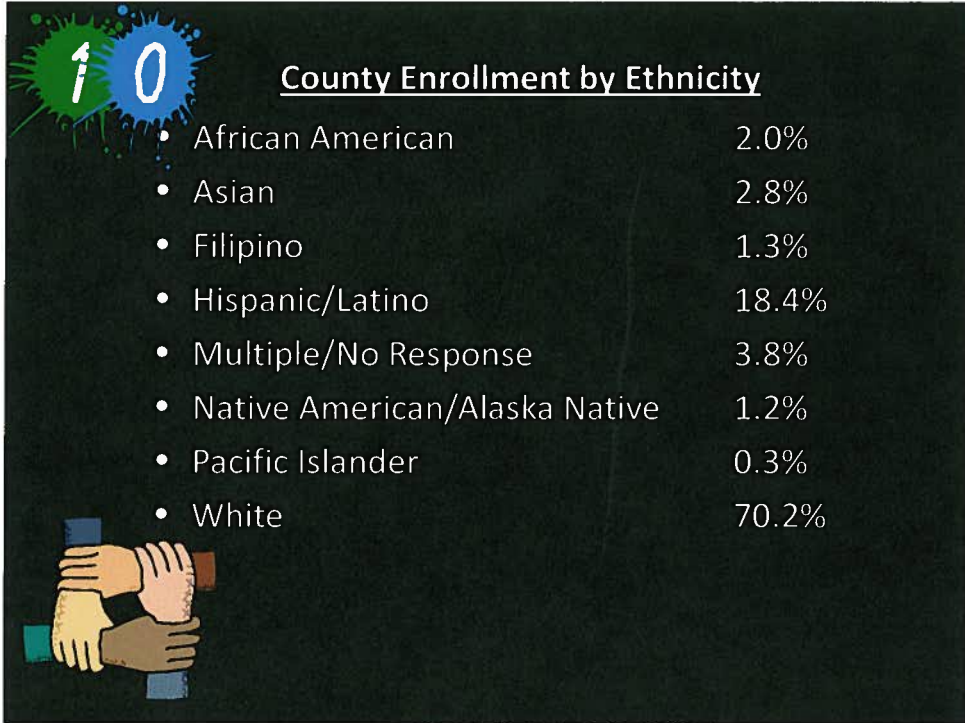
