RE: RATIFICATION OF THE 2025 CALIFORNIA FIRE CODE DUE TO LOCAL CLIMATIC, GEOLOGICAL, AND TOPOGRAPHIC CONDITIONS.

Attached are the 2025 California Fire Code adoption packets for El Dorado County fire districts. These changes to the California Fire Code have been adopted by the Board of Directors for each local fire agency.

To ensure a consistent level of safety for the community and first responders, as well as continuity for the building industry, all 2025 Fire Code adoption ordinances have been aligned, with only minimal differences based on the climatic, geological, and topographic conditions unique to each region (e.g., snow, lakes, etc.) for the following fire districts:

1. Cameron Park Fire Department
2. Diamond Springs-El Dorado Fire Protection District
3. El Dorado County Fire Protection District
4. El Dorado Hills County Water District (El Dorado Hills Fire Department)
5. Lake Valley Fire Protection District


The following fire districts plan to adopt the 2025 California Fire Code; however, due to current operational response needs, adoption is anticipated to be completed in late 2025 or early 2026:

6. Mosquito
7. Fallen Leaf Lake Community Services District Fire Department
