

NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY

The El Dorado County Department of Transportation has completed an initial study/mitigated negative declaration for the Sly Park Road at Clear Creek Crossing Bridge Rehabilitation Project, Bridge No. 25C0047. Generally, the proposed Project would involve: site clearing, preparation, and earthwork; demolition and removal of the existing bridge structure; construction of new bridge foundations, abutments, retaining structures, deck, and guardrails; widening and realignment of a segment of Sly Park Road; applying pavement overlay and conforming a segment of Clear Creek Road to match the new grade; restoration of existing driveways; installation of culverts and drainage facilities; and re-vegetation of disturbed areas. A more detailed project description is included in Section 3 of the Initial Study/Mitigation Negative Declaration document.

The initial study and mitigated negative declaration documents may be reviewed and/or obtained from the Department of Transportation at 2850 Fairlane Court, Placerville, CA during normal business hours or on the DOT website at <http://www.edcgov.us/DOT/ceqa.html>. A mitigated negative declaration is a document filed to satisfy the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and states that the project will not result in significant environmental effects. The public review period for the mitigated negative declaration is thirty days, beginning **June 09, 2010 and ending July 09, 2010**.
