

RESOLUTION NO. 9068

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
PLACERVILLE RESCINDING RESOLUTION #9040 AND REPLACING WITH
A NEW RESOLUTION REQUESTING \$20,000 IN FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE
FROM EL DORADO COUNTY FOR THE 2021/2022 FISCAL YEAR TO HELP
OFFSET SOME OF THE MAINTENANCE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH
PROVIDING A COMPREHENSIVE AQUATICS PROGRAM AT THE CITY OF
PLACERVILLE AQUATICS CENTER**

WHEREAS, the City and El Dorado County continue to work together for the benefit of our community; and

WHEREAS, in the past the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors has been sympathetic to the fact that approximately 76% of the people who utilize the City Aquatics Center reside outside the City limits; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution #9040 at its meeting held on January 11, 2022 requesting \$20,000 from El Dorado County for Fiscal Year 2021/2022 to offset some of the maintenance and operational costs associated with providing a comprehensive aquatics program during the summer months; and


WHEREAS, Resolution No, 9040 did not comply with California Government Code Section 25551 that requires a 4/5 vote of the Resolution, and the City Council desires to adopt a new resolution by a 4/5 vote:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Placerville hereby rescinds Resolution #9040 and requests \$20,000 in financial assistance from El Dorado County for the 2021/2022 fiscal year to help offset some of the maintenance costs associated with providing a comprehensive aquatics program at the City Aquatics Center.

The foregoing Resolution was introduced at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Placerville held on April 26, 2022, by Councilmember Thomas, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Neau. A poll vote was taken, which stood as follows:
