



 - Public Review Period: 2/28/25 4/02/25



Project Overview:

- → Project Goals:
 - → Connectivity between Henningsen Lotus Park and SR 49 Approx. 2,300 LF
 - Class I Multi-Use Trail (safely accommodate multiple user needs)
 - → Tie into natural trails, park, SR49 sidewalk/bike lane
 - Accommodate Bicycles, Pedestrians, etc.
 - → Minimize Impacts To Surrounding Resources








Project History & Alternatives:

- Class I Multi-Use Trail (Near Lotus Road)
 - Coincides with Existing Facilities (Ties into nature trails, parking areas, bicycle user needs, pedestrian needs)
 - Minimizes Environmental Impacts
 - Above Flood Plain/High Water
 - Utilizes County Right-of-Way (No new ROW)
 - Consistent Prior Studies
 - Grant Funding Potential



- → Opportunities to Integrate with Existing Features, Projects, and Needs






<u>Public Review – Draft IS/MND</u> Design Features

- Integrate with Connectivity and Existing Facilities
 - Connects SR49 improvements with Henningsen Lotus Park
 - Improves Safety and Connectivity of 2 roadside Parking lot Areas
 - Preserves existing trail connections at Parking Areas
 - Potential Crosswalk improvements near SR49
 - Does not preclude future nature trail projects

Anticipated Schedule


Overview Schedule:

- → **Planning & Design** 2023 thru 2026
 - (includes: CEQA/ NEPA clearances, Geotechnical Exploration, Structural Evaluation, etc.)
- → Right of Way Certification Caltrans 2025 No ROW-ROW Cert
- → Construction 2026/2027 (Pending Funding)
- Scope Future Phases- Partner with State to extend features to Marshall Gold Discovery Park. Study potential extension of features to Bassi Rd.
