



SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. _____

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 8.38 AND
REPEAL CHAPTER 8.40 AND CHAPTER 8.41 OF THE EL DORADO
COUNTY CODE RELATED TO THE HAZARDOUS MATERIALS
PROGRAM**

This Ordinance updates and consolidates under one chapter, which is a revised Chapter 8.38 – Hazardous Materials, all regulated elements of the Certified Unified Program Agency (“CUPA”) pertaining to facilities that generate, store, or treat hazardous materials or hazardous waste. The amendment to Chapter 8.38 includes the following: changing the chapter title, updating the definitions, incorporating state laws and regulations for implementation and administration of CUPA, establishing a program for issuance of Consolidated Permit to Operate for regulated activities, and updating the administrative enforcement procedures for violations and the process for permit approval, denial, modification, suspension, or revocation. This Ordinance repeals Chapter 8.40, with the provisions related to underground storage tanks to be consolidated and incorporated into the revised Chapter 8.38. Chapter 8.41 prohibiting sale of fuel containing MTBE in the Lake Tahoe Basin is also repealed and will not be replaced as those provisions have now been superseded by state law.

Adoption of this ordinance will be heard by the Board of Supervisors December 10, 2019, in the Board Meeting Room, 330 Fair Lane, Placerville, California.
