Through the Veterans Emergency Relief and Stability Program, we seek to expand and enhance vital services to meet the growing needs of our veteran community. Our grant program is to ensure that no veteran in El Dorado County is left behind lifting our fellow veterans from crisis to stability. We assist homebound, homeless and otherwise afflicted vets with mobility devices (scooters, wheelchairs, canes crutches, clothing, blankets and/or temporary shelter) and any household items to enhance their safety and security.

We seek to expand and enhance vital services to veterans to meet the growing needs of our community and to provide housing for the growing homeless veteran population.

In the past year our organization has provided over \$3,500 in direct financial assistance to veterans facing homelessness and utility shut-offs. We have delivered critical resources like food, firewood, wheelchairs, scooters, furniture, medical equipment, transit passes, transportation, tents, bedding, clothing and even provided professional critical plumbing/electrical repairs. Additionally, we have paid for critical dental services, emergency medical treatments, prescriptions, professional licensing fees, and coordinated housing placements.

We have oftened coordinated with other veteran organizations to share in financial assistance due to organizational dimished relief funds.

El Dorado County has one of the largest county veteran populations in California, home to more than 17,000 veterans.

El Dorado County veterans are vulnerable to extreme high cost of living in California. The exorbitant cost of power, property maintenance and fire abatement plus sky rocketing property insurance. Our EDC veterans seeking assistance have limited incomes and can fall through the cracks.

Our mission is rooted in the shared goal of the Dorado County Veteran Services and we have been long-standing pillars of support for El Dorado County's veterans. VFW 10165 is one of the top two most active veteran service organizations in the county.

Over the past several years we have provided direct financial assistance, and shelter, preventing homelessness in some cases. We have paid critical utility bills/preventing shut-offs, offered food, tax relief and assistance to combat predatory entities that target veterans. Many vets had been victims of crime, abuse, robbery, scams or fallen on temporary hard times. Our programs are often the lifeline for many vets and once on their feet some have returned with gratitude and provided help/assistance to other vets paying it forward.

How will this program/project in this grant request address the need described above?

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Our program will offer:

- **Emergency Financial Assistance -** Rent, Utilities, Food (work, medical)
- **Home Heating and Plumbing Repairs -** Veterans living in unsafe or substandard housing (not cosmetic or major construction repairs).
- Job Training and Employment Support Certification programs, licensing fees and job placement (not covered via VA programs)
- Mental Health Services Access including referrals to counseling, support groups and crisis intervention (not provided by VA or EDC community health)
- Substance Abuse Rehabiltation for veterans needing treatment and recovery support
- Medical Aid and Mobility Support Urgent healthcare needs (medical/Dental/Aides)
- **Transportation Issues** Transit passes, Transport to employment, medical/dental appointments, Vehcile Fuel, Emergency repair, & Tires.

Our organization is patriotic, and **charitable**, that works to strengthen comradeship among its members and other Veterans. Our organization *assists* our fellow comrades, vdeterans and their surviving spouses and ophans. We are proven and remain committed to working with other veterans organizations and El Dorado County Veteran Resource representatives assisting El Dorado County veterans in crisis.

Our organization is charged with putting the interests of our veterans first, and treating our donors as "partners" in this responsibility. There is nothing more important than serving our veteran community and their families.

What is the grant timeline and major milestones of this project?

The expendature of the grant funds will be led by the orgainization leadership with audits of funds conducted by elected trustees. Our success will be treacked through service logs, follow-up interviews, and coordination with partner agencies. Veterans' outcomes will be monitored to ensure long-term stability and wellbeing.

We anticipate no issues is spending the full \$20,000 grant with California's high cost of living crisis. Additionally, we will keep grant budgets separate from our (VFW 10165) Relief funds and general funds.

Our goals during the grant period are:

- Preventing homelessness; emergency financial housing assistance for at least 25 veterans.
- Improving living conditions; heating and plumbing repairs for at least 10 veteran households.
- Mental health and rehabilitation services referrals of at least 20 veterans.
- Job training programs; enroll at least 15 veterans.
- Employment assistance; help 10 veterans to secure employment.
- Transportation services; provide access to health, employment and essential services to at least 30 veterans.

We will asssit veterans fight homelessness, increase living conditions and provide access to metal health, rehabilitation and general health services. Our veterans will have options in job training, licensing and employment assistance.

The number of the EDC Veterans we are able to provide assistance is the leading metric., however the overall measurements are based on the assistance provide.

The impact of our assistance will emphasize independence while maintaining the dignity of the veteran. We will set the veteran up for success so the veteran is not dependant on continued financial assistance.

Service logs, dollar amount of aid along, follow-up interviews and repeat requests will all provide an assessment of our efforts as well as provide a metrics to measure overall projected need in the remaining months of the grant. Our metrics will also provide qualitative information for future budeting in the following years.
