At the EDCTC Board meeting on February 3, 2011, the Commission approved the allocation of Rural Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP) funds for FY 2009/10 (Resolution 10/11.17). A Regional Priority Project, the El Dorado Trail Culvert Replacement, was allocated \$400,000. This is a joint project between the El Dorado County Department of Transportation and the City of Placerville.

The Resolution notes that the *Lead agency will be determined at a later date*. The County and the City have agreed that the County will be the lead agency for the delivery of this project. The City of Placerville will be submitting a similar letter of concurrence.
