3. 10-0598

Chief Administrative Office, Procurement and Contracts Division, recommending the Board authorize the Purchasing Agent to sign PO201111017 for the purchase of two additional Three Axle Dump Trucks with Dump Body in accordance with Bid No. 10-760-075 to the sole qualified bidder, Riverview International Trucks, LLC of West Sacramento, CA in the amount of \$331,645.89 plus all applicable taxes and fees to replace current trucks that do not meet air quality standards and do not qualify for retrofits or repowers for the Department of Transportation.

FUNDING: Non-General Fund, Road Fund.

Chief Administrative Office, Procurement and Contracts Division, recommending the Board approve and authorize the Chair to sign Amendment II to Agreement for Services 631-S0910 with Viking Shred of Sacramento increasing the not to exceed amount of the Agreement by \$42,530 for a total not to exceed amount of \$100,000 for a two-year period through April 30, 2012 for the destruction of confidential documents, e-waste, and other media for County departments located on the western slope.

Development Services Department requesting the continuance of the following matter for 30 days to Tuesday, March 15, 2011 for the Board's adoption of a policy to extend Tentative Maps expiration dates to at least three years or longer.

7. <u>11-0117</u>

Environmental Management Department recommending the Board adopt a Resolution authorizing the Director, or his/her designee, to execute and submit an application and all necessary documentation to the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (Cal Recycle) to secure grant funding in the amount of \$29,197 for the Local Government Waste Tire Cleanup and Amnesty Event Grant Program Fiscal Year 2010-11 to help divert waste tires from landfills.

**FUNDING:** Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (Cal Recycle). Grants.

8. <u>10-0222</u>

Fair Manager recommending the Board approve and authorize the Chair to sign the El Dorado County Fair 2011 Budget, previously approved by the Fair Board of Directors at their October 27, 2010 meeting, and the California Department of Food and Agriculture, Division of Fairs and Expositions on January 24, 2011.

9. <u>11-0114</u>

Health Services Director recommending the Board ratify her signature on an extension application to the California Emergency Management Agency grant for Recovery Act - Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) funding to extend the end date of the grant term from March 31, 2011 to September 30, 2011 with no increase to the original grant amount of \$293,654 to provide continued substance abuse treatment for adult criminal offenders convicted of nonviolent drug offenses in the Offender Treatment Program (OTP) in conjunction with a drug court model.

**FUNDING:** American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) funds via California Emergency Management Agency (CalEMA) and the California Alcohol and Drug Program.

10. <u>10-1326</u>

Health Services Department, Mental Health Division, and Department of Human Services recommending the Board authorize the Chair to sign retroactive Memorandum of Understanding 048-162-M-R2011 with the El Dorado County Office of Education as the Administrative Unit of the El Dorado County Special Education Local Plan Area "SELPA" and the Lake Tahoe Unified School District as the Lake Tahoe Unified SELPA, (jointly referred to herein as the "SELPAS"), in the amount of \$525,000 for the term January 1, 2011 through June 30, 2011 to set forth the roles of each agency in providing mental health services to students with disabilities in accordance with the student's Individualized Education Program.

FUNDING: SELPAS.

11. <u>11-0127</u>

Health Services Department and Department of Human Services recommending the Board approve and authorize said Departments to each sign a letter of support for El Dorado County Community Health Center to submit with their application for a CMSP Local Health Connections Pilot Project implementation grant, noting that this grant, if received, is intended to address the need for access and linkage to health care services for the homeless population in our community.

Department of Human Services recommending the Board, as the Governing Board of the In-Home Supportive Services Public Authority (IHSS PA), authorize the Chair to sign a second Amendment to Interagency Agreement 384-O1111 with the EI Dorado County IHSS PA that defines the responsibilities of the parties relative to the administration of the In-Home Supportive Services Program, adds language to accommodate the recently legislated waiver process for employing individual providers with certain criminal convictions, and adds language regarding the county, state and IHSS PA's immunity of liability resulting from granting such a waiver.

**FUNDING:** 85% Federal/State In-Home Supportive Services Public Authority Funds with 15% required County Match met with realignment funds.
