



RESOLUTION NO. 188-2021

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

Resolution to Change Existing Weight Limits on Mt. Murphy Road Bridge

WHEREAS, the County of El Dorado Ordinance Code Section 12.20.020 authorizes the Board of Supervisors to set county bridge weight limits by resolution;

WHEREAS, Resolution 257-81 set the bridge weight limits for Mt. Murphy Road (No. 75/25C0004) bridge crossing the South Fork of the American River: weight limit of 14 tons per vehicle, 21 tons per semi-trailer combination, 27 tons per truck and full trailer;

WHEREAS, on September 25, 2021, the Mt. Murphy Road Bridge structure was struck and damaged by a vehicle, which the Department of Transportation (Transportation) repaired, and upon further engineering evaluation Transportation recommends a downgrade of the weight limits for the Mt. Murphy Road Bridge; and

WHEREAS, Transportation recommends setting the bridge weight limits for Mt. Murphy Road (No. 25C0004) bridge crossing the South Fork of the American River: weight limit of 12 tons per vehicle, 19 tons per semi-trailer combination.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors set the bridge weight limits for Mt. Murphy Road (No. 25C0004) bridge crossing the South Fork of the American River to 12 tons per vehicle, 19 tons per semi-trailer combination, replacing the previous weight limits under Resolution 257-81.
