This loss of income is due to the unavailability of the Veterans Memorial Building (130 Placerville Drive) during the recent Caldor fire. The VMB is where VFW Post 10165 prepares and serves their "Second Sunday Community Breakfast. These breakfasts are part of our effort to provide the community with quality, low cost meals, and at the same time raise funds for our Post. All of the funds raised at our breakfasts stay here in El Dorado County to assist needy veterans and their families.

CalFire and USFS commandeered our parking lot for their Incident Command Center and Media office. We understand that need at a time of crisis in the County. A low average attendance at our breakfast is 100 patrons. We charge \$6.00 per person, so we are asking to be reimbursed \$600.00 for lost revenue for the breakfast we had to cancel on September 12th, 2021.
