Bone on behalf of Residents for a Safe Cameron Park, following the Planning Commission's approval of Planned Development Permit Revision PD-R20-0009 for Grocery Outllet at Green Valley Station or Planned Developmen Permit Revision PD-R20-0009 for Grocery Outlet at Green Valley Station, Phase II on December 9, 2021. Immely filed on December 22, 2021, Appeal PD-A21-0001 is a request submitted by Law Offices of Robert M.
