I only have 5.9 years of service credit with the County, because the first two years I worked here was under a contract as a consultant, and those years don't count. Based on the 5.9 years of service credit, I'll receive about \$11,240 dollars that will go into my so-called Health Savings Account. I won't start getting anything from PERS until 6-8 months from now, and again because of my limited amount of years of service credit, I'll get about \$800 per month. This is not big bucks, in my book.

My offer to return as part time Extra Help in my current position was simply to make the transition for my staff easier, as DOT goes forward with yet another reorganization plan, which right now, no one knows for sure what that structure will be. There may not even be a Right of Way Manager in the new organizational structure.

So again, the idea that I'm getting some sort of special deal, or that this will cost the County more money, is just not true. In any event, I will accept your decision, no matter what it is, and either move forward or move on.
