

## RESOLUTION NO. 047-2022

## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, representatives of the County of El Dorado and representatives of Operating Engineers Local Union No. 3 (Union), representing employees in the Trades and Crafts (TC) bargaining unit have met and negotiated in good faith since March 31, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, said representatives have reached an agreement on a variety of terms and conditions of employment for employees in the TC bargaining unit to be incorporated as the successor Memorandum of Understanding for the period covering July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, members of the Union representing employees in the TC bargaining unit have held election(s) and voted to ratify the negotiated terms and conditions contained within the tentative agreement for the successor Memorandum of Understanding; and,

WHEREAS, the previous Memorandum of Understanding between the County of El Dorado and the Union representing employees in the TC bargaining unit expired June 30, 2021, and the County of El Dorado and the Union are now bringing the negotiated and fully executed successor Memorandum of Understanding that is attached and incorporated herein to the Board of Supervisors for final approval.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado approves, adopts, and authorizes the Chair to sign this Resolution and the successor Memorandum of Understanding that is attached and incorporated herein between the County of El Dorado and the Operating Engineers Local Union No. 3, representing employees in the Trades and Crafts bargaining unit, for the period July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024.
