





### Plans and Needs




- Increase community recognition of EDC role
- Optimize utilization of operation budget
- Improve dialogue with EDC DA and courts to support prosecution of CDFW violations and imposition of appropriate fines
- Adapt to cost increases for Kid's Fishing Derbies
- Address issues regarding lake/pond health (invasive plants, increased H<sub>2</sub>O temperature, low O<sub>2</sub> levels and cyanobacteria blooms)
