### Environmental Management Department

#### Fire Recovery

- Staff continue to assist constituents with parcel status updates and answering questions.
- ▶ EMD successfully recruited the recent allocation of 2 limited term Development Aides.
- Staff attended outreach events and meetings with the residents of Grizzly Flats and USFS cabins.
- ▶ EMD is following Planning & Building's fee waiver structure for septic and wells.
- ► Collaborated with Planning & Building on a 1-page document on how to obtain a Temporary Recreational Vehicle (TRV) Permit.

#### State Consolidated Debris Removal Program\*

- ► EMD has processed 595 Full Program & 179 Hazard Tree Only ROE's (774).
- ▶ 2 special inclusion requests were accepted by FEMA for the Pioneer Fire Station and Grizzly Flats Community Church.
- ▶ 94% of the parcels have completed debris removal leaving hazard trees and erosion control as the last steps before being returned to the County.
- Once EMD receives notification of a completed parcel, the property owner is notified within 24-48 hours.
- 262 (34%) parcels have been returned to the County.

## Environmental Management Department

#### **Alternate Private Program\***

- 29 applications were received.
- ▶ 16 parcels have completed debris removal.
- 8 parcels have submitted completion reports.
- ▶ 6 parcels have been returned to the owners (5 in Grizzly Flats, 1 in Twin Bridges).

#### **Abatement Properties\***

▶ 6 abatement orders have been issued, recorded and in the process of cleanup.


