#### Commissioners:

In a previous email, dated 4-12-2022, I called your attention to the fact Kimley-Horn conducted their studies on different Wednesdays during the month of May 2021, and how this has a potential to skew the data based on data from Kimley-Horn which showed a distinct difference in volumes of vehicles during the 1700-1800 hrs time frame.

Since sending you my email on 4-12-2022, I studied the Rescue Union School District calendars for the period Kimley-Horn submitted traffic data during the week of May 11-17 and May 26.

An odd coincidence I found could explain a reason why the study was delayed and performed on May 26 -

PLEASE SEE THE snipets from the Rescue Union School District webpage below - you will see that during the weeks of April 1 - May 22, every Wednesday the Green Valley Elementary School was on early release schedule for K-5<sup>th</sup> grade. This is basically the entire school getting out early and many parents probably drove back and forth on Green Valley Rd to pick up students. While this data could be valid in showing actual changed traffic patterns - the numbers of vehicle trips would simply shift sooner during the day from the regular

However, depending on the students involved for each family could be making two trips if they had a TK child enrolled, the Kimley-Horn study for turning movement avoided such data because they moved the "Intersection Turning Movement Count" to 5-26-2021.

May 26th was the first Wednesday during the Green Valley School schedule wherein they did not have an Early Release day, and the last day of school was May 28th.


Kimley-Horn does not address a reason to not reflect the Intersection Turning Movement Count on the same day actual counts were performed on May 12th, as it should have been.

#### **Question or Comment**

Hello, We are residents of the Green Springs Ranch at the corner of Green Valley and Deer Valley Roads. It has been brought to our attention that the hearing on April 14th with Agenda Item #4 will discuss the Summer Brooks Developers request to remove the conditions for approval which would have required the installation of a traffic light. A traffic light has previously been approved for this intersection, and now it appears that this prior approval is being reconsidered. In the four years since we have owned our home, we have seen traffic increase significantly at this intersection, and this will only increase with the new development. To turn left or West from Deer Valley Road onto Green Valley can cause a long wait with a stream of cars, as well as a long delay to turn left into the development.
