AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 12.04 OF THE ORDINANCE CODE FOR EL DORADO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, PROVIDING FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF STREETS, SIDEWALKS, AND PUBLIC PLACES

## THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Findings

Whereas, Ordinance No. 5051, adopted by the Board on April 17, 2017, amended the El Dorado County Ordinance Code to reflect the reorganization of the Community Development Agency into separate departments of Environmental Management, Planning and Building, and Transportation; and

Whereas, said ordinance also amended the El Dorado County Ordinance Code to state that "the Department of Transportation shall be administered by a county officer to be known as the Director of Transportation," and "where referenced in state statute or elsewhere in this Code, the Director of Transportation or his/her designated representative shall serve as Road Commissioner;" and

Whereas, said ordinance states that references throughout the El Dorado County Ordinance code shall be updated to reflect the new organizational structure.

<u>Section 2.</u> Title 12 – Streets, Sidewalks, and Public Places, Chapter 12.04 is hereby amended as follows:

## Sec. 12.04.010. Road district established.

Pursuant to Streets and Highways Code § 1020, and for the purpose of levying a local property tax to implement other funds available for improvement and maintenance of County highways, the boundaries of the five road districts previously established are changed to create one road district to consist of all the unincorporated territory of the County.
