

RESOLUTION NO. <u>045-200</u> OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO ESTABLISHING DISPOSAL METHODS FOR SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY OF NO VALUE

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado has established a County ordinance providing for the disposition of personal property not required or no longer adequate for County use, and

WHEREAS, said personal property, being designated as "surplus to the needs of the the County" by the Board of Supervisors, is disposed of via sale or donation to community organizations, and

WHEREAS, said ordinance does not address the disposition of surplus personal property which is determined to be beyond economical repair or usefull life and thus of no resale value, and

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to provide a method for disposal of said items of no value.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Supervisors hereby resolves as follows:

- 1. All items declared surplus to the needs of the County shall be inspected by appropriate qualified staff for the purpose of determining operability and useful life of said items.
- 2. Those items found to be beyond economical repair or of little or no value shall, at the discretion of the Director of General Services, or designee, be disposed of in one of the following manners:
 - a. recycling
 - b. trash disposal
