



Dear El Dorado County Procurement and Contracts,

This Letter of Protest is in response to my recent bid submission as incumbent contractor for El Dorado County Office Supplies Contract, ITB #21-615-048.

Regarding Section III, Item D, References:

Four references were provided. Total points given were 2.5. To support this protest, I would like to add the following for additional consideration:

Reference 1: The County of El Dorado's previous contract length is 10 years in which Sierra Office Supplies has provided fulfillment of offices supplies and printing services per the contract.

Reference 2: San Francisco 49ers Organization has been provided with signage services for 5 years.

Reference 3: The Shingle Springs Band of Miwok Indians contract length is 12 years in which Sierra Office Supplies provides fulfillment of office supplies and printing services per the contract.

Reference 4: Calaveras County contract length is 8 years in which Sierra Office Supplies provides fulfillment of office supplies and printing services per the contract.

Regarding Section XXI, Invoices and Payments:

A descriptive summary of invoicing with flexibility was provided and a sample invoice was included which mimics the same invoicing procedure as our previous contract(s) with El Dorado County. No points were given for the response to this section. I would like reconsideration for a minimum of 1.00 point if possible.

Regarding Pricing in which we received a full twenty points I would like to assert that provided pricing was well below both contracted and noncontracted items compared to Bidder "B" and Bidder "C."

I would like to reiterate that Sierra Office Supply qualified for local area business with local storefront and our services provide local county revenue.
