BUDGET TRANSFER JUSTIFICATION AND DESCRIPTION* (will be scanned into FENIX TCM)

Planning and Building Department, Airports Division, requests a budget transfer adjusting the budget for Fiscal Year (FY) 2021-22 to reallocate salary savings and projected General Fund contribution between the Placerville and Georgetown Airports to allow for an increase in professional services for both airports.

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) recently changed a policy and now requires the County to provide upfront funding for preliminary scoping, surveys, and other analyses required for the environmental process for obstruction removal, beacon tower replacement, and other Airport Capital Improvement Progam (ACIP) projects. If the County does not provide the upfront funding, then the County will be unable to obtain FAA design and construction grants for those ACIP projects.

In order to meet the FAA's grant deadlines to obtain obstruction removal grants and the Georgetown beacon tower replacement grant in the next grant cycle, and to keep other projects on track, it is important that the County front project expenses in the current fiscal year for several other small projects at both airports.

The Placerville Airport is budgeted to received a general fund contirbution, but it also has enough salary savings to cover the professional services cost increase in both airports. The Georgetown Airport is budgeted to receive a general fund contribution, but does not have enough salary savings to cover the cost increase. Therefore, the Department is requesting to reduce the general fund contribution in the Placerville airport, as well as the salaries and benefits budget, and to increase the general fund contribution for the Georgetown Airport a corresponding amount. Staff was not aware that these project tasks needed to be completed in FY 2021-22 and was, therefore, unable to include these expenses in its FY 2021-22 budget
