FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES #6451

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Consultant has been engaged by County to provide as-needed airport design, engineering, and construction management services for its Planning and Building Department, pursuant to Agreement for Services #6451, dated April 5, 2022, incorporated herein and made by reference a part hereof (hereinafter referred to as "Agreement");

WHEREAS, County and Consultant are required to comply with California Public Contract Code Section 2204 as the compensation amount of the Agreement exceeds \$1,000,000, thus adding ARTICLE LXVI, Iran Contracting Act Certification, and Exhibit F:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the mutual promises and covenants hereinafter contained, County and Consultant mutually agree to amend the terms of the Agreement in this First Amendment to Agreement for Services #6451 on the following terms and conditions:

I. The following article is added to the Agreement.

ARTICLE LXVI

Iran Contracting Act Certification: As required by California Public Contract Code Section 2204, for Agreements that are over \$1,000,000, Consultant certifies its status regarding the Iran Contracting Act of 2010 and has duly executed Exhibit F, marked "Iran Contracting Act Certification," incorporated herein and made by reference a part hereof.

Except as herein amended, all other parts and sections of Agreement for Services #6451 shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect
