RESOLUTION NO. 9069

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE REQUESTING \$76,500 IN FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM EL DORADO COUNTY FOR THE 2022/2023 FISCAL YEAR TO HELP OFFSET SOME OF THE MAINTENANCE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH PROVIDING A COMPREHENSIVE AQUATICS PROGRAM AT THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE AQUATICS CENTER

WHEREAS, the City and El Dorado County continue to work together for the benefit of our community; and

WHEREAS, in the past the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors has been sympathetic to the fact that approximately 76% of the people who utilize the City Aquatics Center reside outside the City limits; and

WHEREAS, the City is requesting \$76,500 from El Dorado County for Fiscal Year 2022/2023 to offset some of the maintenance and operational costs associated with providing a comprehensive aquatics program during the summer months; and

WHEREAS, this increase to \$76,500 reflects 76% of the Maintenance expenditures for the Placerville Aquatic Center based on fiscal year costs averaged from 2014 through 2021:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Placerville hereby requests \$76,500 in financial assistance from El Dorado County for the 2022/2023 Fiscal Year to help offset some of the maintenance costs associated with providing a comprehensive aquatics program at the City Aquatics Center.

The foregoing Resolution was introduced at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Placerville held on April 26, 2022, by Councilmember Thomas, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Neau. A poll vote was taken, which stood as follows:
