

RESOLUTION NO. 105-2022

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado conducted a hearing on the appropriations limit for El Dorado County on June 28, 2022;

WHEREAS, the hearing was advertised and noticed as required by law: and,

WHEREAS, the Board received testimony and other evidence regarding the appropriation limitation to be established for El Dorado County; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado that the El Dorado County appropriations limit for the 2022-2023 fiscal year, as described in Article XIIIB of the State Constitution and implemented by Chapter 1205, Statutes of 1980 is the sum of \$270,869,885 computed as follows:

2022-2023 Increase in the California per capita personal income is 7.55% or the factor of 1.0755; 2022-2023 Decrease in Population is -0.32% or the factor of 0.9968; 1.0755 (X) 0.9968 = 1.0721 is the combined factor for increasing the 2022-2023 appropriation limitation.
