OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, representatives of the County of El Dorado and representatives of El Dorado County Law Enforcement Management Association (Association), representing employees in the Law Enforcement Sworn Management (SM) bargaining unit have met and negotiated in good faith since February 3, 2022; and

WHEREAS, said representatives have reached an agreement on a variety of terms and conditions of employment for employees in the SM bargaining unit to be incorporated as the successor Memorandum of Understanding for the period covering January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, members of the Association representing employees in the SM bargaining unit have held election(s) and voted to ratify the negotiated terms and conditions contained within the tentative agreement for the successor Memorandum of Understanding; and,

WHEREAS, the previous Memorandum of Understanding between the County of El Dorado and the Association representing employees in the SM bargaining unit expired December 31, 2021, and the County of El Dorado and the Association are now bringing the negotiated and fully executed successor Memorandum of Understanding that is attached and incorporated herein to the Board of Supervisors for final approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado approves, adopts, and authorizes the Chair to sign this Resolution and the successor Memorandum of Understanding that is attached and incorporated herein between the County of El Dorado and the El Dorado County Law Enforcement Management Association, representing employees in the Law Enforcement Sworn Management bargaining unit, for the period January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2023.
