
Changes Requiring Our Programs to Evolve

- Prolonged Periods of Smoke and Poor Air Quality
- Entire South Shore Community Evacuated in Early Fall 2021 (Caldor Fire)
- Outdoor Events Negatively Impacted Sample the Sierra 2021 Canceled
