Please accept this memo as a weekly update to the activities surrounding the County of El Dorado's recovery from the Caldor Fire as managed by the Recovery Operations Center's (ROC) co-directors Sgt. Moke Auwae and me.

Environmental Management

• Alternate Program

- o 7255 Winding Way- Contactor states it has been cleaned, EMD has not received any documentation, and has not observed sampling. Began the abatement process.
- 5221 Butte Creek Road- EMD has authorized an extension until 9/30/22 for completion.

• USPS Grizzly Flats

o USPS filed a workplan on 9/8/22, the alternate program application is incomplete, the site was posted on 9/13/22.

USFS Parcels

- o 168 Debris removal complete (99%)
- o 149 Soil samples approved (88%)
- o 133 Erosion Control Complete (79%)
- o 108 completed ROE sign-off (returned to owner)

- TRV Building Permits 41 Received
 - o 25 Issued
 - o 16 Pending
