Medi-Cal – low cost or no cost medical insurance. This program can assist with transportation assistance to doctor’s appointments, help gain access to In Home Health Services (IHSS), and help pay Medicare Part A and/or Part B premiums.



CalFresh – also known as SNAP benefits. This program provides monthly food benefits to individuals and families with low-income. This program can also assist in acquiring a free or reduced CA ID & financial relief of utility bills (HEAP referrals).



CalWORKs – time-limited cash assistance for families with children. This program can assist with clothing support, free diapers & wipes, and activity bags for children.

General Assistance

General Assistance – repayable program that helps indigent persons meet basic needs by providing vouchers for housing, utilities, personal needs and transportation.
