OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO ADOPTION RESOLUTION EL DORADO COUNTY 2023-2024 BOATING SAFETY AND ENFORCEMENT FINANCIAL AID PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the California Department of Parks and Recreation Division of Boating and Waterways provides annual funding through the Boating Safety and Enforcement Financial Aid Program to the El Dorado County Sheriff's Office for boating safety and enforcement activities on the County's rivers and lakes; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code, Section 663.7(e) The department shall not allocate funds to any county or a public agency within a county unless the department receives a resolution adopted annually by the board of supervisors authorizing the county to participate in the program and certifying that the county will expend for boating safety programs during that year not less than an amount equal to 100 percent of the amount received by the county from personal property taxes on vessels. The money allocated to a county pursuant to subdivision (a) shall be used only for boating safety and enforcement programs, as specified in subdivision (a), that are conducted in that county; and,

WHEREAS, the Sheriff, or Chief Fiscal Officer of the Sheriff's Office shall sign the application and subsequent contract and claims; and,

WHEREAS, the County Auditor shall certify the amount of prior year vessel taxes received by the County,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors authorizes the County Sheriff's Office to participate in the program funded through the Boating Safety and Enforcement Financial Aid Program Agreement and certifies that not less than 100% of the County's Boat Taxes will be expended on its boating safety and enforcement program.
