The Surveyor's Office is in the process of applying for a federal Fire Prevention and Safety Grant. The notice of the grant availability was announced on January 6<sup>th</sup> and applications are due by February 4<sup>th</sup>, 2011. This short time frame has not allowed for the Surveyor's department to obtain prior Board approval by the application deadline.

We will be applying for grant funding to support the continued development of our Emergency Planning and Support application. This web-based application supports community emergency awareness and preparation. The applications present a dynamic map of emergency routes, hydrant locations, and sheltering facilities. All of these elements require updating and maintenance. There is a need to complete the data; verify the data, provide an effective and immediate method to correct or update the data; and to provide this functionality to those who are best able to manage its accuracy.

Additionally the application could play a critical role during a disaster such as a wild land fire. It could be the information source for emergency responders not familiar with the area and for residents needing information over mobile devices when landlines are no longer available.

We expect the grant request will be for at least \$100,000 to fund database and software development. The grant has a 12 month maximum performance period, requires no matching funds, and is a competitive process. Awards to successful grant applicants will be announced beginning in September 2011.
