A. The good/service requested is restricted to one supplier for the reason stated below:

1. Why is the acquisition restricted to this goods/services supplier? (Explain why the acquisition cannot be competitively sourced. Explain how the supplier is the only source for the acquisition.)

Alliant Insurance Services is the exclusive broker under Public Risk Innovation, Solutions and Management (PRISM) and has sole authority to represent PRISM programs to California public agencies.

2. Provide the background of events leading to this acquisition.

On January 12, 2010, with Legistar 09-1484, the Board of Supervisors awarded RFP 10-961-101 for employee benefits consulting services to Alliant. The County and Alliant negotiated an initial 3 year contract term.

On February 15, 2011, with Legistar 11-0121, the Board of Supervisors entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with CSAC-EIA (EIA) to join the CSAC-EIA Health program (EIA Health). In 2020, EIA changed its name to PRISM. PRISM is a Joint Powers Authority (JPA) comprised of California counties, cities, and public agencies organized to jointly develop and fund insurance and related programs with the most favorable terms and costs. As Alliant is the exclusive Broker to the PRISM risk sharing insurance programs, the County has renewed its agreements with Alliant upon expiration of each Alliant contract term.

3. Describe the uniqueness of the acquisition. (Why was the goods/services supplier chosen?)

Alliant is the exclusive Broker to the PRISM risk sharing insurance programs. They represent the development, underwriting, marketing and customer service model related to the implementation of the coverages. This includes the Property Casualty Programs and the Employee Benefit Programs. Alliant is under contract with PRISM and has sole authority to represent PRISM programs to California public agencies. This was done in support of a cohesive and robust service model that better serves the programs by creating continuity in service delivery to the program Members. Members of PRISM's insurance programs can elect a different broker, however, it is at Alliant's discretion as to whether or not they continue to allow that entity access to the PRISM programs. While the County can elect a different broker, we do so at the probability of losing access to the PRISMHealth program (the County's Health, Dental/Vision and ancillary benefit programs), as Alliant does not exercise that discretion.

4. What are the consequences of not purchasing the goods/services or contracting with the proposed supplier?

The County could elect a different broker, however, we could lose access to the PRISMHealth program which includes the County's Health, Dental/Vision and ancillary benefit programs. It is at Alliant's discretion as to whether or not they continue to allow us access to the PRISM programs if we were to elect a different broker.

5. What market research was conducted to substantiate no competition, including the evaluation of other items or service providers? (Provide a narrative of your efforts to identify other similar or appropriate goods/services, including a summary of how the department concluded that such alternatives are either inappropriate or unavailable. The name and addresses of suppliers contacted and the reasons for not considering them must be included OR an explanation of why the survey or effort to identify other goods/services was not performed.)

Not applicable. Rather, we confirmed through PRISM's Director of Employee Benefits that Alliant is the exclusive Broker to the PRISM risk sharing insurance programs, and that while members of PRISM's insurance programs can elect a different broker, it is at Alliant's discretion as to whether or not they continue to allow that entity access to the PRISM programs, and that Alliant would not be expected by PRISM to exercise their discretion, resulting in our likely loss of access to PRISM's programs.

B. Price Analysis:

1. How was the price offered determined to be fair and reasonable? (Explain what basis was used for comparison and include cost analysis as applicable.)

There are no changes to the rates reflected in our existing Agreement 4474 with Alliant Insurance Services. Agreement 4474 has been in place since February 1, 2020.

2. Describe any cost savings or avoidance realized (one-time or ongoing) by acquiring the goods/services from this supplier.

The County has successfully controlled costs of the health plans offered through PRISM Health, and therefore by extension through Alliant, as PRISM's exclusive Broker to the PRISM risk sharing insurance programs. Specific cost savings cannot be calculated as we avoided higher costs through our participation in PRISM.
