Please accept this memo as a weekly update to the activities surrounding the County of El Dorado's recovery from the Caldor & Mosquito Fires as managed by the Recovery Operations Center's (ROC) co-directors Sgt. Moke Auwae and me.

## **Environmental Management**

## **CALDOR FIRE**

- Alternate Program
  - 5221 Butte Creek Road- waiting on soil sample results. Deed Restriction has been recorded 12/16/2022.
  - 4991 Sciaroni Rd (USPS) Soil Sample results submitted. Waiting on final close out paperwork from the contractor.

## **MOSQUITO FIRE**

- ROE universe is 22. We have received 19.
- Permitted Structures (12 ROEs expected):
  - 10 ROEs received
  - 7 approved
  - 2 are waiting on corrections
- Other Structures (unpermitted dwellings & outbuildings. 10 ROEs expected):
  - 9 received
  - 8 approved
  - 1 is waiting on corrections
- Vehicles:
  - 36 noted on ROEs
  - 7 have been requested by owners to be excluded (they will deal with the vehicle disposition themselves)

- Fee Waivers 129 received
  - Temporary Mobile Homes/Temporary Recreational Vehicles
    - 75 Received

- 93 Approved (even if parcel owners didn't request a TRV/TMH but were eligible for temporary power and demo permit, we included TRV/TMH in the initial approval in case of future need)
- **Rebuild Permits** 67 received
  - o 3 Building Permits Submitted & approved w/ Permit Fees Waived
  - o 33 Building Permits issued w/out Permit Fees Waived
  - o 31 Building Permits Pending w/out Permit Fees Waived
- **TRV Permits** 50 Received
  - o 35 Issued
  - o 15 Pending
