








Total Operating Appropriations of \$1,983,206




Net County Cost of \$1,599,088

- Addressing Fees
 - Fees collected when a project requires a new or updated address
- Administration Fees
 - Deposition Payment
- Certification Fees
 - Certification of Correction fees
 - Certification of Compliance fees
- GIS Service Fees
 - Fees associated with work provided by GIS team, and ESRI charges
- Map Check Fees
 - Associated fees for mapping work



Service and Performance Indicators

- Map Check Timely and efficient processing that meets state law and county ordinance.
 - Map review process & project completion meets required time frame 98% of the time.
- Addressing Create & maintain addresses consistent with county standards and public need.
 - Current addressing requirements are up to date and accurate. Survey Technicians review needs daily to stay current.
- Parcel base Develop & improve the parcel base to provide the best possible product to the county.
 - The County parcel base is revised daily. 99% of all recorded maps, 97% of all recorded deeds are entered into the system.
- GIS Services Develop & maintain data management apps, create exhibits for county staff and public.
- Public Assistance Assist El Dorado County residents by listening & providing information to develop problem resolutions.
