

RESOLUTION NO. 052-2023

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO TO APPROVE HIGHWAY RESTRICTIONS FOR THE 30TH ANNUAL AMERICA'S MOST BEAUTIFUL BIKE RIDE SUNDAY, JUNE 4, 2023

WHEREAS, The Leukemia and Lymphoma Society, Inc. (LLS) proposes to conduct the 30th Annual America's Most Beautiful Bike Ride; and

WHEREAS, the 30th Annual America's Most Beautiful Bike Ride will temporarily impede and restrict free passage of traffic over State Highway Routes 50 and 89 on Sunday, June 4, 2023, between Stateline through South Lake Tahoe between the hours of 6:30 a.m. and 9:00 a.m.; and with the approval of Cal Trans and the California Highway Patrol, close northbound Emerald Bay Road (Hwy 89) to vehicular traffic to allow bicycle participants, event course vehicles and emergency vehicles access only from 6:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado approves and consents to the proposed 30th Annual America's Most Beautiful Bike Ride and recommends approval of the consents to the proposed restriction of State Highway Routes 50 and 89 and closure of Highway 89 from 6:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m., upon terms and conditions deemed appropriate and necessary by the State of California, Department of Transportation.
