COLOMA LOTUS AREA CONTRIBUTIONS TO EL DORADO COUNTY'S ECONOMY







WHERE DO VISITORS STAY WHEN THEY COME TO THE COLOMA LOTUS AREA?






Of the 1,400 people surveyed 1,143 disclosed their origin of travel.

988 came from within California with the majority coming from Northern California



GROSS REVENUE





EMPLOYEE COUNT








TRANSIENT OCCUPANCY TAX




SALES TAX
