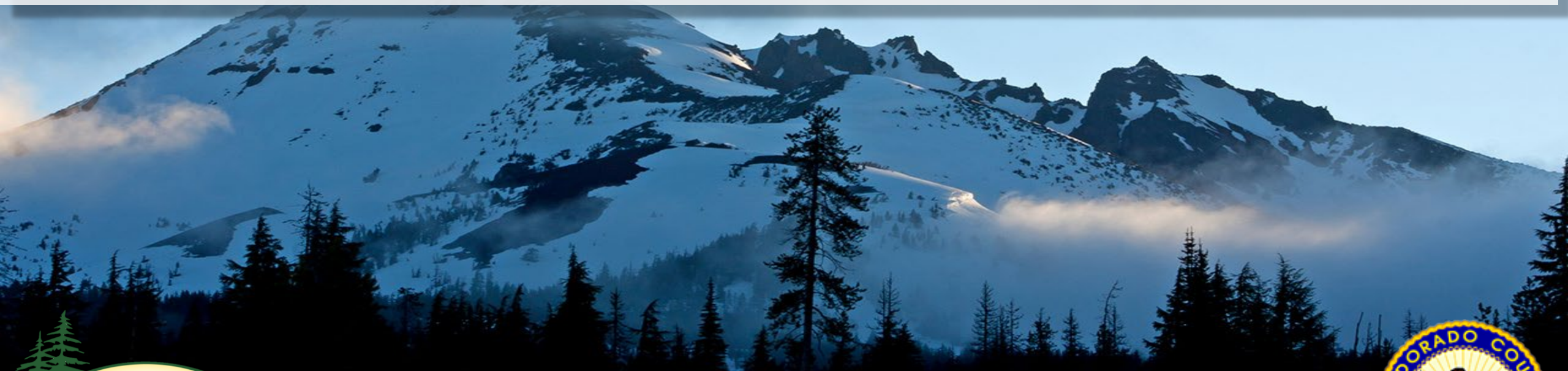

Definition of Group Home and Short-Term Residential Therapeutic Programs

“Group Home”: A facility which provides 24-hour care and supervision to children, provides services specified to a specific client group, and maintains a structured environment, with such services provided at least in part by staff employed by the licensee. *Any facility providing 24-hour care for seven or more children must be licensed as a group home.*

“Short-term residential therapeutic program (STRTP)”: A residential facility that provides an integrated program of specialized and intensive care and supervision, services and supports, treatment, and short-term 24-hour care and supervision to children that is trauma-informed.

El Dorado County Children's Facilities

- Summitview Child and Family Services
 - Licensed STRTP (18 bed capacity)
 - Licensed Group Home (12 bed capacity)
- New Morning Youth and Family Services
 - Licensed Group Home (12 bed capacity)



Summitview STRTP & Group Home

- El Dorado County agencies (Child Welfare, EDCOE) placed two youth at Summitview in calendar year 2021.
- Outside counties (28) placed 95 youth at Summitview in calendar year 2021.
- El Dorado County agencies (Child Welfare, EDCOE) placed zero youth at Summitview in calendar year 2022.
- Outside counties (28) placed 114 youth at Summitview in calendar year 2022.

(Outside county referrals come from Child Welfare, Aid to Adoptive Parents, Education, Kaiser Insurance, and Juvenile Probation.)



New Morning Youth Shelter

- Approximately 125 unique youth find shelter at New Morning annually.
- El Dorado CPS referred 2 youth in calendar year 2021 and 5 youth in calendar year 2022.
- Referrals come from Child Protective Services (CPS), Student Attendance Review Board, school districts, community-based therapists, law enforcement, parents, neighbors, and sometimes the youth self-refer.

Monitoring and Oversight

- CA Department of Social Services, Community Care Licensing
- CA Department of Health Care Services
- El Dorado County Behavioral Health (EDCBH)
 - Authorizes and provides oversight of the Specialty Mental Health Services (SMHS) provided at the STRTPs
 - Ensures that the STRTPs are current with Medi-Cal site certification
 - Manages the flow of Presumptive Transfer youth who are placed at an STRTP and need authorization for services
