## EXHIBIT B

## CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS, TITLE 24, PART 9, CALIFORNIA FIRE CODE, AMENDMENTS

## CLARIFICATIONS (UNDERLINED PORTIONS)

Chapter 9, Section 903.2:

Exceptions:

1. One and two family dwelling units (R-3 Occupancies). <u>(See Section R313 of the 2010 California Residential Code that requires all one and two family dwellings to be equipped with an NFPA 13D sprinkler system.)</u>

2. Agricultural buildings, <u>except any agricultural building which is</u> not under special use permit used for commercial purposes (e.g. retail sales, food service and/or special events).

Chapter 9, Section 907.2.a:

Exceptions:

1. One and two family dwellings (R-3 Occupancies <u>and other occupancies</u> <u>classified as "U.")</u>

2. Agricultural buildings, <u>except any agricultural building which is</u> not under special use permit used for commercial purposes (e.g. retail sales, food service and/or special events).

Chapter 38, Section 3804.3:

Footnote "d" - becomes 250 gallons. Installation of DOT tanks, with setbacks from structures less than 10 feet, must be approved by the <u>Fire AHJ.</u>

Chapter 38, Section 3813:

Permits and Plans. Permits shall be required and plans shall be submitted for all underground tank installations and approved by the <u>Fire</u> AHJ.
