



RESOLUTION NO.
OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO
Adopting the El Dorado County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan

Whereas, El Dorado County recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within our community; and

Whereas, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences; and

Whereas, the U.S. Congress passed the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (“Disaster Mitigation Act”) emphasizing the need for pre-disaster mitigation of potential hazards; and

Whereas, the Disaster Mitigation Act made available hazard mitigation grants to state and multi-jurisdictional governments; and

Whereas, an adopted Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) pre- and post-disaster mitigation grant programs; and

Whereas, El Dorado County fully participated in the FEMA-prescribed mitigation planning process to prepare this Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

Whereas, the California Office of Emergency Services and FEMA Region IX officials have reviewed the El Dorado County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan and approved it contingent upon this official adoption of the participating governing body; and

Whereas, El Dorado County desires to comply with the requirements of the Disaster Mitigation Act and to augment its emergency planning efforts by formally adopting the El Dorado County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

Whereas, adoption by the governing body for the El Dorado County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, demonstrates the jurisdiction’s commitment to fulfilling the mitigation goals and objectives outlined in this Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

Whereas, adoption of this legitimizes the plan and authorizes responsible agencies to carry out their responsibilities under the plan;

Now, therefore, be it resolved, that the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors adopts the El Dorado County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, attached hereto as Attachment A;

Be it further resolved, that the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors incorporates the above-adopted Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan as part of the Safety Element of the General Plan;

Be it further resolved, El Dorado County will submit this adoption resolution to the California Office of Emergency Services and FEMA Region IX officials to enable the plan's final approval in accordance with the requirements of the Disaster Mitigation Act.
