Thank you for your support of The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society (LLS) and its Team In Training program over the years, and for inviting us to be a part of your wonderful ride. America's Most Beautiful Ride is the largest cycling event Team In Training participates in, raising significant funds for LLS's research programs year after year.

Team In Training[®] (TNT), the world's leading endurance sports charity training program, provides four to five months of personalized coaching and training to run or walk a full or half marathon, participate in a triathlon, a century (100-mile) bike ride or a hike adventure. TNT also provides the opportunity to meet new people and be part of a supportive team. In addition to weekly training sessions under the guidance of a certified coach, TNT offers clinics on nutrition, equipment, injury prevention and safety. Participants are given tools to help them raise funds for blood cancer research and patient services. In exchange for the fundraising and training, LLS arranges airfare and lodging to send participants to the event of their choice. Since TNT's inception 500,000 participants have raised over \$1 billion.

This year we are bringing over 1500 riders from 59 chapters to America's Most Beautiful Bike ride on June 5th and expect to raise over \$6.5 million dollars. Over the past 14 years, TNT has brought nearly 19,500 participants to the America's Most Beautiful Bike Ride event, bringing our total raised to \$68.5 million dollars!

Since its founding in 1949, LLS has invested more than \$750 million in research specifically targeting leukemia, lymphoma and myeloma. LLS's patient services department offers a comprehensive array of education and support services for blood cancer patients and their families.
