
Sec. 130.80.020 Definitions of Specialized Terms and Phrases.

Home Occupation (Use Type). A business operated out of a residential dwelling or accessory structure or outdoors on the residential parcel, by a resident of the premises, and that is compatible with surrounding residential and agricultural uses. Home occupations may include, but are not limited to, work performed by telephone, mail, or by internet, or appointment; home offices; Cottage Food Operations (CFO), small scale production and repair, handicrafts, parts assembly; or work or craft that is the activity of creative artists, music teachers, academic tutors, trainers, or similar instructors.
