NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that a road closure will be in effect for Marshall Road between Greenwood Road and Garden Valley Road from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m., on Monday, July 4th, 2011, subject to the conditions set forth in Resolution No. 110-79 dated May 1, 1979, and subject to the conditions set forth in the Application for Road Closure submitted for this event.

This Resolution and the Application with conditions shall together constitute the Road Closure Permit.
