WHEREAS, El Dorado County Commercial Wineries earned the following California State Fair awards: 1 Best of California, 1 Best of Show - Red, 1 Best of Region Red Sierra Foothills Appellation, 2 Best of Class, 1 Double Gold, 14 Gold, 65 Silver, 48 Bronze Medals.
