**WHEREAS,** wine grapes grown in 2010 in El Dorado County almost reached 4,700 tons (9,400,000 lbs); and

**WHEREAS,** wine makers both Homemade and Commercial have produced phenomenal results at the 2011 California State Fair Wine Competition earning top honors which reflect great credit on El Dorado County and its wine and wine grape production; and

**WHEREAS,** Richard Turrone of El Dorado Home Wine Makers and James and Alanna Taff of Windwalker Vineyard and Winery have earned the top 2011 awards for red wine in the State of California at the California State Fair; and

*WHEREAS*, El Dorado County Home Wine Makers earned the following individual California State Fair awards:1 Best of California, 1 Best of Show - Red, 4 Double Gold, 3 Gold, 19 Silver, 10 Bronze, 8 Honorable Mention; and

*WHEREAS,* El Dorado County Commercial Wineries earned the following California State Fair awards: 1 Best of California, 1 Best of Show - Red, 1 Best of Region Red Sierra Foothills Appellation, 2 Best of Class, 1 Double Gold, 14 Gold, 65 Silver, 48 Bronze Medals.
