Enclosed is a guide to the hundreds of operating historic railroad museums and railroads in California, the United States and North America. Many of these operations are operated by volunteers and the funding, if not supported outright by private donations, are in large part supported by collected fees and private donations. The attraction to persons both young and old provided by these historic preservations is self evident as is also the dollar benefits provided to the communities that support them. The California State Railroad Museum, the Durango and Silverton Railroad in Durango Colorado, the Nevada Northern Railroad in Ely Nevada and the Virginia and Truckee Railroad in Virginia City Nevada are four of many examples of operating historic railways that provide much tourist revenue and unrivaled attraction to the cities and rural areas that house them. The rail corridor that has existed between Folsom and Placerville since the 1880's has the potential to be the equal of the most attractive of the operating historical railroads that I have visited throughout the country. I understand that a conflict has arisen concerning the possible use of the right of way for trail use only rather than continue to develop the operation of the historic railroad. I recently had the opportunity to ride the P&SVRR on one of its first runs from Hampton Station to the Latrobe area and was pleasantly surprised by the beauty of the rural areas that we traveled through as were the others on board. It appears to me that the sixty to one hundred foot wide legal right of way has more than enough room to provide trail usage along with the railroad. To elaborate upon dual usage the trail users could use the future facilities and rolling stock of the railroad to ride the trains one way and return to point of origin on the trails. The Durango and Silverton furnishes similar services to bikers, hikers and backpackers in Colorado as do other operators throughout the country. To extend rail operations along the entire length of existing track would allow the possibility of the P&SVRR to become equal to or better than the best in the country! And please remember that most of what has transpired was made possible by the foresight and efforts of the Sacramento Placerville Transportation Corridor- Joint Powers Authority and the outstanding effort of the many volunteers who have done the track and rolling stock restoration work at little or no cost to the taxpayer. Hopefully these first fledgling scheduled short trips of the august 7 and 8 weekend along this ninety year old track can be the beginning of a world class operating railway museum that will bring many benefits to your communities. What other potential revenue sources do you have that are provided by so many dedicated unpaid volunteers?


