Respondents to RFI

Bateman Senior Meals

- Headquartered in Atlanta, Georgia
- Provides frozen meals the Asian Community Center of Sacramento Valley Inc. (serving all of Sacramento County) and Seniors First (serving the west slope of Placer County)

Treat America

- Headquartered in Merriam, Kansas
- No experience providing senior meals in California
- Prefers not to service South Lake Tahoe

El Dorado County Senior Nutrition Program Congregate Dining Centers

- Provides a restaurant experience for seniors
- Provides fresh hot meals Monday Friday
- Provides a wide variety of fresh fruits and vegetables, salads, homemade soups
- Large volunteer base
- Covers the entire County including remote sites

El Dorado County Home Delivered Meals Program Monday – Friday Delivery

Daily delivery of fresh meals

Daily social interaction

Daily welfare checks on vulnerable elders

Large Volunteer Base

Benefits to Local Economy of El Dorado County Based Program

- Grant dollars remain in our County
 - \$491,312 is received from Federal and State funds plus a required County match. (The General Fund contribution to program budgeted for FY 11/12 is \$585,720.)
- Supports local economy
 - Majority of food and supplies are purchased locally
 - Majority of EDC staff live within the County

Quality Control

- Local Quality Control
 - El Dorado County currently sets the standards
 - Outsource would result in loss of quality control ability

Oversight Requirements

- Oversight of the outsourced vendor would still be required.
- Projected cost to County is \$174,682/year for the following oversight:
 - Program Monitoring
 - Area Agency on Aging Dietitian
 - Fiscal
 - Data
 - Training and Technical Assistance

Per Meal Cost FY 2010/2011 Dining Centers

- EDC Senior Nutrition Program: \$8.16
 - Cost to service all of El Dorado County (West Slope and South Lake Tahoe)
- Asian Community Center of Sacramento Valley Inc.: \$7.90
 - Cost to service Sacramento County
 - Frozen meals are delivered to 22 sites
- Seniors First:
 - Cost to service the West Slope of Placer County was unavailable
 - Frozen Meals are delivered to the Auburn site only

Per Meal Cost FY 2010/2011 Home Delivered Meals

- EDC Senior Nutrition Program: \$8.64
 - Cost to service all of El Dorado County (West Slope and South Lake Tahoe)
 - Meals are served hot 5 days per week

Asian Community Center of Sacramento Valley Inc.: \$7.80

- Cost to service Sacramento County
- 5 days of frozen meals are delivered once per week

Seniors First:

- Cost to service the West Slope of Placer County was not available
- Frozen meals are delivered to Auburn site only
