In Recognition of the 2010 Oak Ridge High School Girls "Lady Trojans" Basketball Team

WHEREAS, on March 27, 2010, the Oak Ridge High School "Lady Trojans" Girls Basketball Team made history in what is described as "one of the most stunning upsets in girls' state championship history" when they won the California 2010 Interscholastic Federation Division I State Title; and,

WHEREAS, in winning the State Championship, the Lady Trojans achieved a 55-42 victory to triumph over the four-time California Division I State Champion with a national ranking of third, Long Beach Polytechnic High School "Jackrabbits" Girls Basketball Team; and,

WHEREAS, determined to make it to the State Championships, the Lady Trojans dedicated countless personal hours throughout the off-season and into the fall, to ultimately win the State Championship Title as part of their successful 33-3 record 2009-2010 season; and,

WHEREAS, in winning the 2010 State Championship, the Lady Trojan team comprised of Sara James, Megan Griswold, Caitlin Welsch, Kristie Kaiser, Kelsi Danciart, Jodie Richards, Lauren Adams, Kristen Ramona, Alexa Pickett, Stefanie Walberg, Dakota McLarnan, Carly Bettencourt, Natalie Stone, Hayley Padua-dean, Lindsay Honaker, Katie Hoisington, Jenna Klein, Kaitlyn Lendrum, Lauren Sende and Haley Anderson, was also the first large school from the Sac-Joaquin Section to win a State, District I Basketball Title; and,

WHEREAS, the Oak Ridge High School Girls Basketball program has achieved numerous section titles and victories under the leadership team of Coach Stephen White and Assistant Coaches Lynn Webb, Sam Mellerup, Karl White, Greg Lamy, Annie Lamy, Alyse Kopp, and Shannon O'Neill.
