It is with mixed feelings that I submit my resignation letter as a community representative of the El Dorado County Child Abuse Prevention Council, effective immediately.


My current employment commitment has become too great for me to effectively fulfill the requirements of my position on the council and I feel it is best for me to make room for someone with the time and energy to devote to the job.


