

Proclamation OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

Recognizing January 30, 2012 – April 4, 2012 as A SEASON FOR NONVIOLENCE in El Dorado County

Whereas, every person can move the world in the direction of peace through their daily nonviolent choice and action; and

Whereas, programs to promote peace and conflict resolutions found in schools and communities throughout our nation are positively affecting our families and our neighborhoods, one day at a time; and

Whereas, an awareness of nonviolent principles and practices is a powerful way to heal, transform and empower our lives and communities; and

Whereas, January 30, 2012 and April 4, 2012 commemorate the memorial anniversaries of Mahatma Gandhi and Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED January 30, 2012 through April 4, 2012 as A SEASON FOR NONVIOLENCE in El Dorado County and encourage all citizens to participate in local and national campaigns to honor those who are using nonviolence to build communities that respect dignity and worth of every human being.
