



RESOLUTION NO.
OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

**Resolution to Authorize the Director of Transportation to Temporarily Close a Section of
Newtown Road between the Westerly and Easterly Intersections of Fort Jim Road for the
Construction of the Contract Overlay – Newtown Road (5 Miles) Project During the
2011/2012 Construction Seasons**

WHEREAS, the County plans to overlay Newtown Road for Capital Improvement Project No. 72184 during the 2011/2012 construction seasons; and

WHEREAS, in order to install the overlay, Newtown Road between the westerly and easterly intersections of Fort Jim Road will need to be closed from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. for ten (10) weekdays; and

WHEREAS, an alternate access route/detour will be available during the temporary closure and traffic will be directed by signage to this route/detour; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 21101 (e), the Board of Supervisors is authorized to temporarily close a portion of any street for the safety and protection of persons who are to use that portion of the street during the temporary closing; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 21101 (e) and California Streets and Highways Code Section 942.6, the Board of Supervisors may designate the Director of Transportation to determine the exact dates and times for the closures;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Director of Transportation is authorized to order the temporary closure of Newtown Road between the westerly and easterly intersections of Fort Jim Road, for ten (10) weekdays in order to overlay Newtown Road and to establish an alternate access route/detour for traffic use during the time of temporary closure. The precise dates of the temporary road closure are to be determined by the Director of Transportation, with notification of the pending temporary road closure and detour to be provided to the County Supervisor of District 2, business owners, residents, the general public, the El Dorado County Transit Authority and to safety and law enforcement agencies in the Project area, through direct communications, signage, or flyers.
